

AUDIO TOUR DRIVING DIRECTIONS

STOP 1: C. H. Jennison

- From **Goff Drive**, enter **Circle Drive**.
- Take **East Ninth Lane** into the cemetery.
- After about 150 feet, stop at the cedar tree on your left.
- Look for green tour marker on right side.
- From the marker, walk 10 paces from the road (past *Carter* and *Napier*) to *Jennison*.

STOP 2: Chestnut and Merritt

- Continue on **East Ninth Avenue** to "T" intersection.
- Turn left on **11th St. Entrance Road**.
- Make first right on **West 10th Lane**.
- Look for the green tour marker on your left.
- Ten paces in, look for heart-shaped headstone of *Lee Chestnut*.

STOP 3: Peter W. Walton

- Continue on **West 10th Lane** to end.
- Bear left and stay left onto **West Eleventh Lane**.
- Look for tour marker by first lot on right.
- Walk past unmarked lots to *Walton* mausoleum.

STOP 4: Bannister

- Continue on **West Eleventh Lane**.
- Take first left on **11th St. Entrance Road**.
- Look for tour marker on your left.
- From your car you can see headstones in shapes of a fireman's badge and an apple.

STOP 5: Woodmen of the World forest.

- Continue on **11th Street Entrance Road**.
- Turn right on **East Ninth Lane**.
- Make first left on **9th Street Entrance Road**.
- Turn left onto **West Seventh Lane**.
- Stop at tour marker on your left.
- Look around for numerous headstones shaped like tree stumps.

STOP 6: Confederate Soldiers: Ingalls and Dickens

- Continue on **West Seventh Lane** as it angles to the right.
- Take first right on **West Sixth Lane**.
- Look for tour marker on your right.
- Lot is adjacent to road.

STOP 7: Charlie Etta Burney

- Continue on **Sixth Lane** all the way to end.
- Exit the Main Gate.
- Turn left on **Goff Drive**.
- Turn left on **East Fourth Lane** to reenter cemetery.
- Look for tour marker on your left.
- Walk past *McKay* and *Crosby* to *Burney*.

STOP 8: Marion Darling

- Continue on **East Fourth Lane** which becomes **West Fourth Lane**.
- After second intersection, look for tour marker on your left.
- *Darling* headstone is in *McDougal* lot.

STOP 9: Perry Jenkins Williams

- Does not require driving.
- Walk from *Darling* back toward road.
- Look for statue of woman holding wreath.

STOP 10: Henry H. Kimball

- Continue on **West Fourth Lane**.
- Just a few lots beyond the cedar trees, look for tour marker on your left next to *Cheshire*.
- Find *Kimball* just beyond *Cheshire*.

STOP 11: Frank Jacobs

- Continue on **West Fourth Lane** to the end.
- Angle right on **West Seventh Lane**.
- Continue along perimeter of cemetery and take the third right on **West First Lane**.
- Look for tour marker on right corner, just across **East Road**.

STOP 12: Richard Fowler King

- Continue straight as **West First Lane** becomes **East First Lane**.
- About halfway to the end, look for tour marker on right.
- Lot is adjacent to road.

- B. Wings gravestone
