# City of Moultrie Manufactured Home Plan Submittal and Building Permit Application

Manufactured homes must conform to the character of the surrounding neighborhood as determined and approved by the Director of Planning and Community Development (Planning Director) or his or her designee

The Planning Director must compare the proposed manufactured home to the <u>compliant</u> site built and other housing located, constructed, or permitted in a two-block area of the site where the manufactured home is proposed to be located. Approval shall be granted upon the finding that the manufactured home is substantially similar in:

— size,	— siding material,	— front and side window
— height,	— roof material,	openings,
— scale,	— roof style,	— porch area and style,

- provision of garage and carport, including location, and
- foundation to existing development or proposed development in the same area.
- a. All towing devices, wheels, axles, and hitches must be removed at the time of installation.
- b. There must be a covered landing at each exterior door. The landing must be a minimum of thirty-six inches.
- c. Wood, brick, or masonry must enclose any open area between the floor of the manufactured home and the ground upon which the foundation rests.
- d. The home must front a public street.
- e. The home shall not exceed a body length width ratio of 3:1.

Before permanent power can be approved, the following items must be completed: permanent foundation; minimum 36"x36" covered landing at all exit doors; removal of tongue, axles, transporting lights, and towing apparatus.

#### **Inspections**

## The installer $\underline{must}$ notify our office for the Certificate of Occupancy inspection $\underline{before}$ the building is occupied

## Give 24 hours prior notification when requesting inspections.

Post a field copy of the permit on site in a conspicuous place prior to commencing work. Comply with all applicable local, state and federal laws, codes, rules, regulations, etc. Request applicable required inspections:

Rough: Home is installed per installation instructions, provided with this permit Installation of plumbing, electrical, and mechanical.

Marriage line must be sealed and moisture barrier installed.

Skirting should not be installed until rough inspection has passed.

Final: Home installation is complete with decks, porches, steps, skirting and permanent enclosures.
