

**MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION HELD BY MOULTRIE CITY COUNCIL  
ON TUESDAY, JULY 17, 2018 AT 5:01 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL CONFERENCE  
ROOM**

**1) Call to Order**

Mayor McIntosh called the meeting to order.

**2) Presentation from Larry Franklin**

Larry Franklin spoke to Mayor and Council about getting water and sewer to the Enclave subdivision without having to annex the property into the City. Mayor and Council told Mr. Franklin they would consider his request and they would make a decision on or before the August 7, 2018 council meeting.

**3) Review Council Meeting Agenda Items**

City Manager Dillard reviewed the items on the agenda.

**4) Request to Purchase City Property**

The consensus of the Mayor and Council present was to bid out the property between County Farm Road and Sunrise Avenue.

**5) Donation of Retired Aircraft at Spence Field**

The consensus of the Mayor and Council present was to continue to be on the wait list for a retired T-6, T-33, and T-37 aircraft to be placed at the Spence Field entrance.

**6) Other**

Police Chief Sean Ladson was present to answer questions on the proposed alcohol ordinance that would make on premises consumption licensee holders install security cameras. If the proposed ordinance goes into effect, the change would not be effective until January 1, 2019.
