

**MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION HELD BY MOULTRIE CITY COUNCIL
ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018 AT 5:00 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL

1) Call to Order

Mayor McIntosh called the meeting to order at 5:06 PM.

2) Review Council Meeting Agenda Items

City Manager Dillard reviewed the agenda items.

3) Other

City Manager Dillard stated that he and Amy Johnson, Downtown Economic Development and Public Relations Director, attended a GMA Congressional Session in Macon.

Dillard explained that he had been in contact with Omni Tracks and it would be a year project to abandon the railroad tracks from 1st Ave to the Hospital.

Dillard stated that he had meet with Chas Cannon, Colquitt County Administrator, to discuss the Humane Society, Sunset and Spence Field Airport. Dillard discussed a post storm meeting the County held.

Council Member Dunn mentioned the deteriorating state of the election signs that the City distributes every election. Dillard stated he will enquire about the elections signs.

Council Member Clarke Hill asked when the all storm debris would be removed. Clarke Hill has been getting calls from citizens. Dillard stated by the end of November. Discussion ensued about getting help from DOT and private contractors.

Discussion ensued about the traffic light at the intersection of South Main and West Boulevard. Dillard explained the City had already made contact with the DOT but will contact them again.

Dillard stated the Downtown Economic Development and Public Relations office would be selling around 3,000 Christmas bulbs this year. Proceeds of \$5,000 from the bulbs will go to Colquitt County to help repair the Downtown Courthouse clock.
