

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD BY MOULTRIE CITY
COUNCIL ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018 AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL
CHAMBERS**

COUNCIL MEETING

1. Call to Order

Mayor McIntosh called the meeting to order at 6:02 PM.

2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

Council Member Clarke Hill gave the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Consider Approval of Minutes

Work Session – October 16, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.
Council Meeting – October 16, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Member Clarke Hill made a motion to approve the minutes. Council Member Dunn seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

4. Consider Bid for (3) ½ Ton Crew Cab Trucks – Hutson Motors – Moultrie, GA – (1) Engineering Department & (2) Public Works Department

Council Member Clarke Hill made a motion to approve the low and recommended bid in the amount of \$86,985 submitted by Robert Hutson for (3) ½ Ton Crew Cab Trucks with one being utilized by the Engineering Department and two by the Public Works Department. Council Member Barber seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

5. Consider Bid for Backhoe/Machinery replacement – Flint Equipment – Albany, GA – Public Works Department – 2018 TSPLOST Fund

Council Member Castellow made a motion to approve the low and recommended bid in the amount of \$95,277 submitted by Flint Equipment for a Backhoe/Machinery replacement being utilized by the Public Works Department

and coming out of the 2018 TSPLOST fund. Council Member Hadley seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

6. Consider Award of Bid for Property described as Portion of Lot 4 and all of Lot 5 of Block 11, Section 3 of East Moultrie Heights Subdivision

Council Member Hadley made a motion to approve the highest and only bid in the amount of \$10,299 submitted by Robert Hutson AKA “HMC Land Holdings LLC” for City of Moultrie property described at portion of Lot 4 and all of Lot 5 of Block 11, Section 3 of East Moultrie Heights Subdivision. Council Member Barber seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

7. Consider Resolution to Renew the Speed Detection Device Permit from the Georgia Department of Public Safety

Council Member Dunn made the motion to approve the resolution to renew the Speed Detection Device Permit from the Georgia Department of Public Safety. Council Member Hadley seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. *R11-2018-19*

8. Consider Appointments/Reappointments to Moultrie-Colquitt County Land Bank Authority

Council Member Hadley made the motion to approve Council Member Castellow and Clarke Hill to the Moultrie-Colquitt County Land Bank. Council Member Barber seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

12. City Manager’s Report


City Manager Dillard had nothing to report.

13. **Other Business**


