

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD BY MOULTRIE CITY

13. Other Business


Council Member Dunn along with Council Members Castellow, Barber, Clarke Hill and Mayor McIntosh all echoed City Manager Dillard's comment.
