The City of Moultrie, Georgia, will receive **SEALED PROPOSALS FOR ROAD STRIPING IMPROVEMENTS** until 1:30 PM, Wednesday, May 6, 2020, in the city breezeway on 1st Ave. SE, across from the Court House, Moultrie, Georgia, at which time the proposals shall be publicly opened and read. No bid submitted may be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days.

This will be a Georgia Department of Transportation assisted contract and compliance with all state and local laws, rules, and regulations is required. Materials and constructions methods for this project shall be in accordance with Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, Construction of Transportation Systems, 2013 Edition. **Contractor is required to be GDOT Certified.**

THE WORK TO BE DONE consists of restriping approximately 16 miles of city roads within the City of Moultrie limits.

***NOTICE: A MANDATORY Pre-Bid Conference for this project will be held at 1:30 PM, local time, Wednesday, April 22, 2020, in the city breezeway on 1st Ave. SE, across from the Court House, Moultrie, Georgia. Representatives of owner and engineer will be present to discuss the project. Bidders are required to attend and participate in the conference. Engineer will transmit to all prospective bidders of record such addenda as engineer considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.**

Companies, individuals and entities that fail to attend the mandatory pre-bid conference shall not be allowed to submit a bid for the project.
