

**MINUTES OF THE BUDGET WORK SESSION HELD BY MOULTRIE CITY COUNCIL ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2020 AT 5:00 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL CONFERENCE ROOM**
