Dear Friends:

On January 20th of this year, your Mayor and City Council approved a plan to rebate 50% of 2020 paid City of Moultrie property taxes to homeowners over the age of 65. This is a one-time rebate, using funds received from the Federal Government's CARES Act. Enclosed is an application for eligible homeowners to receive this rebate amount in March of 2021.

All individuals in the City of Moultrie organization appreciate the City's long-time, loyal property tax payers and feel this is the group most deserving of this special tax rebate. The cost of this rebate was not and will not be borne by any other group of City property tax payers.

Please complete the application; attach the documents requested; and email, mail, or deliver the application and documents to City Hall by February 26, 2021.

Data will be analyzed and verified so rebate checks can be prepared and mailed in March of 2021.

The excessive cost to the City of dealing with COVID-19 was mitigated by the efficient and effective work of the department directors and all other City employees. When the 2020 fiscal year ended September 30, 2020, it was determined that because of this effectiveness the funds received from the CARES act would be available for this rebate.
