

**MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION HELD BY MOULTRIE CITY COUNCIL
ON TUESDAY, APRIL 19, 2022 AT 5:30 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL CONFERENCE

1. Call to Order

Mayor McIntosh called the meeting to order at 5:32p.m.

2. Review Council Meeting Agenda Items

City Manager Dillard reviewed the agenda items.

Discussion ensued concerning the tattoo and body piercing ordinance. City Attorney Waller asked Mayor and Council to remove the ordinance from the agenda and he would have the corrected ordinance at the next Council meeting.

Council Member Dunn had some concerns about parking for City events on the lease agreement with Georgia Pines. After discussion, City Manager Dillard stated he would compile a separate agreement with Georgia Pines for parking during downtown events.

3. Other

City Manager Dillard proposed an increase in cemetery lots from \$425 to \$600 to be consistent with other local cemeteries. Discussion ensued concerning the cemetery lots but no action was taken.
