General Nature of Work:

Responsible for managing the city mosquito control programs and herbicide/growth retardant programs, as well as ensuring all required state and federal procedures and documentation are followed. Works flexible hours as needed in mosquito control, herbicide/growth retardant application, operating the water truck, and in the maintenance of City properties including growing, planting, and maintaining various plants, trees, shrubs, and turf. Operates heavy and light equipment including water truck, tractor, backhoe, dump truck, mower, weed eater, and blower. Performs other duties as assigned.

Training and Experience:

Must be a high school graduate or equivalent with experience in Public Works activities including mosquito control and herbicide/growth retardant procedures in compliance with state and federal law, as well as experience in landscaping planting and maintenance, and mowing; or, an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the knowledge, skill, and ability to perform the duties of the position. Must possess a State of Georgia Pesticide Applicator's License with necessary categories. Must possess a valid Class "B" commercial driver's license with preference of a Class "A" commercial driver's license.
