Section 36-35-4.1 in Accordance with the Procedures set forth at O.C.G.A. Section 36-35-3(l)(b) to Reapportion Municipal Election Districts in Accordance with the Voting Rights Act of 1965 as amended based upon Publication of the United States Decennial Census of 2020; To Establish New Election District Boundaries in Compliance with the Requirements of the United States Constitution and Pertinent Laws, Governing Future Elections for Members of the Council; To Establish an Effective Date; and For Other Purposes

City Manager Dillard asked Finance Director Tina Coleman to present to council the upgraded bond rating score from an A + to an AA-. This is a huge




