1. Call to Order

Mayor McIntosh called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m..

2. Sara Hand Archway Presentation

Sara Hand gave a community update presentation on the Archway Partnership University of Georgia.

3. Review Council Meeting Agenda Items.

City Manager Dillard reviewed the Council Meeting agenda items.

Mayor and Council discussed Agenda Item #7, the Third and Final Reading of the proposed amendment to the Traffic and Vehicles Ordinance. Several Council members noted they have received multiple complaints from residents expressing concern that the City should not have authority to regulate parking on what they consider private property.

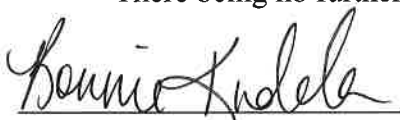

He explained that the City has made prior efforts to address the issue by notifying residents on 1st and 3rd Streets to utilize their existing driveways for parking; however, some residents have refused to comply.

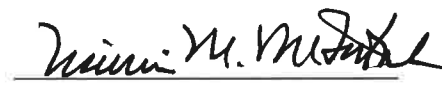
4. Other
